APPLICATION AND AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH WARRANT

Christopher F. Jarosinski, being first duly sworn on oath, deposes and states as follows:

1. That he is an adult residence of the State of Wisconsin who, at all time is material to the allegations set forth herein, was and is a deputy for the Price County Sheriff's Department.
2. Your affiant is currently investigating the disappearance of Marchelle (Shelly) Hansen, f/w, DOB 08-24-64. Your affiant is aware Marchelle Hansen has been reported to the Price County Sheriff's Department as a missing person since November 17, 1987. The last time Marchelle Hansen was seen was November 12, 1987. Your affiant has reviewed reports prepared by then Investigator Richard Heitkemper of the Price County Sheriff's Department concerning the investigation of Marchelle Hansen's disappearance. The reports indicate at the time of her disappearance, Marchelle was employed by Marquip Inc. of Phillips, Wisconsin. The reports indicate Marchelle recently ended a relationship with Gary White also employed by Marquip Inc. during this time. This information was obtained from information provided by Gary White and other employees at Marquip Inc. The reports indicate Marchelle Hansen spent an inordinate amount of time during work hours with a foreman at Marquip Inc., Michael Raskie. The reports indicate at the time of Marchelle Hansen's disappearance Marchelle was pregnant, had undergone an ultrasound that day, and told various associates the father of the child was someone with whom she worked at Marquip Inc. Investigator Heitkemper acquired this information during the course of his investigation while interviewing members of Marchelle's family and from associates and co-workers and Marquip Inc. Your affiant believes the reports of then Investigator Heitkemper because Investigator Heitkemper was a fellow law enforcement officer who acquired the information through the course of duty.
3. Your affiant knows that during the course of the investigation of the disappearance of Marchelle Hansen her whereabouts can be accounted for until afternoon hours of November 12, 1987. That during morning hours of November 13, 1987 Marchelle Hansen's vehicle, a maroon colored Dodge Omni, WI plate KL5306, was located in the parking lot of the Lake Ten tavern owned by Dale Prohaska in the Township of Harmony. Your affiant knows that Marchelle Hansen's residence at the time of her disappearance was apartment #4 of the Starlight Apartments on State Highway 13 north of the City of Phillips, WI.

4. Your affiant knows that when Marchelle Hansen's vehicle was located Steven Raskie, a brother of Michael Raskie, lived at N6658 Pioneer Road approximately one half mile from the Lake Ten tavern. Steven Raskie rented the residence at the time from Alice and Tom Wanish.
5. Your affiant has reviewed a report completed by Special Agent Dennis Miller of the Wisconsin Department of Justice – Division of Criminal Investigation. The report states that on September 13, 1989 SA Miller and Investigator Richard Heitkemper interviewed Steven Raskie. The report lists an occupation of Steven Raskie as a brick layer working for Oscar Bolt Construction Company. The report indicates that Steven stated he lived in a house owned by Tom Wanish from the fall of 1983 until May of 1988. The report indicates that Steven stated he recalled seeing the Marchelle Hansen vehicle in the parking lot of the Lake 10 Resort after her disappearance. The report indicates Steven stated he saw her vehicle two or three days after the vehicle had been there. The report indicates Steven stated he did not know Marchelle Hansen, had never met her, and had never seen her at the Lake 10 tavern as far as he knew. The report indicates Steven stated he heard the rumor that his brother Michael Raskie was responsible for Marchelle's disappearance. Steven stated as far as he knew he has never seen or heard of Marchelle Hansen being with his brother and his brother never told him about being with Marchelle Hansen. Steven stated the last time he could recall Michael Raskie being at his residence was during the spring of 1987 around May or June. Steven stated Michael Raskie was either picking up or dropping off items stored at the residence. Steven Raskie related there had been no other access by anyone to the house other than Tom Wanish who had a key. Steven Raskie was asked whether his brother may have used or spent time at the house. Steve Raskie related that he did not and that again he was not missing anything from his residence nor did it appear that anybody used his residence when he was on the road doing construction work. Your affiant believes the information provided in the report completed by SA Miller because he is a fellow law enforcement officer who acquired the information through the course of duty. Your affiant believes the information provided by Steven Raskie in as much as they are statements made by him against his penal interest.
6. Your affiant has reviewed a Price County Sheriff's Department log entry made by then Deputy Allen Lobermeier of the Price County Sheriff's Department on October 17, 1987. That the entry made at 1:05 a.m. states "Shelly M Hanson HCR3 Box 907 Phillips no phone Starlight Apt. reports Gary White has been harassing her (sexual) this has been happening at Marquip Inc, Phillips. She also reports he broke into her apt. awhile ago with his driver's license. County complaint wants for info and to watch Gary White. (593)" Your affiant believes the information provided by then Deputy Allen Lobermeier because he was and currently is a fellow law enforcement officer who acquired the information through the course of duty.
7. On July 24, 2005 your affiant and Special Agent John Christophersen of the Wisconsin Department of Justice – Division of Criminal Investigation spoke with Gary White. Gary White stated in 1987 he worked at the Marquip Corporation in Phillips, WI. White stated Marchelle Hansen also worked at the business. White stated he, Marchelle Hansen,

Michael Raskie and others would go to taverns after work hours. White stated he had an informal relationship with Marchelle Hansen. White stated he began to pursue Marchelle as a conquest to have sexual intercourse with her. White stated he did this because no one thought he would be able to accomplish it. White stated he recalled an incident when Marchelle was with Michael Raskie. White stated Marchelle had yelled at him saying Michael wanted to leave. White said he had told Marchelle that if she could not wait for him (White) she should go ahead and leave with Michael. White said they had all been planning on going to a party. White said Michael and Marchelle never arrived at the party. White stated the following day he was with Marchelle in Rib Lake, WI. White stated he questioned her about what she had done with Michael. White stated Marchelle denied adamantly that she had engaged in sexual intercourse with Michael. White stated that later that day he and Marchelle began engaging in sexual intercourse. White stated Marchelle was not participating in their contact. White stated he got the feeling that Marchelle was engaging in sexual intercourse with him in the event that she had gotten pregnant while engaging in sexual intercourse with Michael. White stated he stopped engaging in sexual intercourse with Marchelle and had not ejaculated. White stated that after this incident their relationship ended. White stated after this time he tried to tease Michael about engaging in sexual intercourse with Marchelle. White stated he wanted Michael to know that he (White) knew that Michael had engaged in sexual intercourse with Marchelle. White stated Michael never admitted or denied doing this. White stated Michael Raskie would smile and walk away. Your affiant believes the information provided by Gary White because he is a citizen informant who had personal knowledge of the matters in which he spoke.

8. Your affiant has reviewed a report prepared by SA Christophersen. That the report indicates on August 27, 2003 he spoke with Leonard Shilts. That Shilts indicated he was a former police officer for the City of Phillips, Price County, Wisconsin. That Shilts indicated on November 12, 1987 he was working third shift for the Phillips Police Department. That Shilts indicated during his shift between approximately 10:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. he entered the Tazmanian Devil tavern while "making rounds". That while in the establishment he was approached by a female subject identified as Marchelle Hansen. That Marchelle indicated to Shilts she was going away from her residence for a time and asked Shilts to watch her residence. That Marchelle indicated she rented an apartment at an establishment which was once called the Starlight Motel. That Shilts indicated later that night at approximately 2:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m. he drove past the motel. That Shilts stated he observed two vehicles in the parking lot of the motel. That Shilts recognized one of the vehicles, a truck, as that of a vehicle owned by Michael Raskie. That Shilts indicated both vehicles were parked in front of Marchelle Hansen's apartment. Your affiant believes the report prepared by SA Christophersen because SA Christophersen is a fellow law enforcement officer who acquired the information through the course of duty. Your affiant believes the statements of Leonard Shilts because he had personal knowledge of the matters in which he spoke. Your affiant knows that Leonard Shilts is now deceased. Your affiant believes the information provide by Leonard Shilts as your affiant has been able to cooborate the information in the following ways; the log entry completed by Deputy Lobermeier about a report made by Marchelle Hansen about Gary White breaking into her apartment; the statements of Shilts seeing the Michael Raskie

vehicle outside Marchelle's apartment during the early morning hours of Friday November 13, 1987. That Shilts also stated during this interview that he saw a white or light colored car near the Michael Raskie vehicle in front of Marchelle's apartment; your affiant believes that this white or light colored car was or may have been a vehicle owned by Barbara Schwie the next door neighbor of Marchelle Hansen.

9. On July 12, 2004 your affiant and SA Christophersen spoke with David Geboy who indicated during late August or early September of 1987 he observed a male subject known to him as White who worked at Marquip Inc., Michael Raskie, and Marchelle Hansen standing outside the Stonecroft Tavern in the Township of Worcester, Price County, Wisconsin at approximately 5:30 a.m. That Geboy indicated it appeared Marchelle and Michael were engaged in "necking" or kissing each other and White was standing next to Michael and Marchelle. In November of 1987, Marchelle Hansen told Geboy the father of her unborn child was married and had two children. Your affiant believes the statements of David Geboy because he had personal knowledge of the matters in which he spoke. Your affiant has learned as a matter of common knowledge that at the time of Marchelle Hansen's disappearance, Michael Raskie was married and had two children. Your affiant is also aware through the course of this investigation that at this time Gary White was not married and had no children.
10. On March 21, 2005 your affiant spoke with Traci Ellis. Tracy is the wife of Ronald Watral. Tracy indicated Ronald Watral's parents owned the Starlight Apartments in November of 1987. Tracy stated that four apartments were being rented at the time of Marchelle Hansen's disappearance. She stated that a Jerry Hatch lived in apartment #1. She indicated Hatch is now deceased. Tracy indicated John and Bonnie Ramsdell lived in apartment #2. Barb Schwie lived in apartment #3 and Marchelle Hansen lived in apartment #4. Your affiant believes the information provide by Tracy Ellis because she is a citizen informant who had personal knowledge of the matters in which she spoke.
11. On March 16, 2005 and September 24, 2007 your affiant spoke with Barbara (Schwie) Payne of Phillips, WI. Payne stated in November of 1987 she lived in an apartment at the Starlight Apartments next door to Marchelle Hansen. Barbara stated that the walls of the apartments were thin. Barbara stated during the days and or approximate week prior to Marchelle Hansen's disappearance she was woken up by arguments emanating from Marchelle's apartment. Barbara stated she heard a male voice in loud accusatory tones and Marchelle's voice in calming tones. Barbara stated the arguments were violent and extremely intense. Barbara stated during this time frame she could also hear sounds which she recognized as Marchelle and the male subject engaging in sexual relations. Barbara stated the male subject in the apartment with Marchelle Hansen drove a "spruced up" "guy truck" pickup truck with extra accessories with a loud exhaust. Barbara stated at the time of this incident she drove a white or light blue colored Chevrolet car.
12. On October 16, 2007 your affiant spoke with George Valiga, Jr. George stated in November of 1987 his then wife Barbara Schwie-Valiga drove a light blue colored Chevrolet Celebrity. Your affiant believes the information provided by George Valiga, Jr.

because he is a citizen informant who had personal knowledge of the matters in which he spoke.

13. Your affiant has reviewed records provided by Flambeau Hospital per subpoena for Marchelle Hansen. In these records is a note completed by Dr. Dahlie dated November 6, 1987 stating that Marchelle Hansen is pregnant. Also provided is documentation of an obstetrical ultrasound done of Marchelle Hansen at Flambeau Hospital on November 12, 1987 at approximately 12:15 p.m. The report indicates that there is a single living fetus present and fetal heart beat is normal. Also contained within this information are five fetal photographs of the ultrasound. Your affiant believes the information provided by Flambeau Hospital as it is kept in the regular course of business and health care.
14. On January 8, 2007 your affiant and SA Christophersen spoke with Tina Andersen. Andersen stated in November of 1987 she worked with Marchelle Hansen at Marquip, Inc. Andersen stated on the day Marchelle disappeared she spoke with her prior to work hours at Marquip, Inc. Andersen stated Marchelle told her she was pregnant and had a picture of an ultrasound. Andersen stated this was the first information she knew that Marchelle was pregnant. Andersen stated she asked Marchelle the identity of the father of the child. Andersen stated Marchelle would not tell her his name other than he was a foreman at Marquip, Inc. and had two small children. Andersen stated Marchelle was apprehensive about telling the father because she did not want to break up his marriage. Andersen stated Marchelle was scared because her finances were limited but very excited to be pregnant. Your affiant believes the information provided by Tina Andersen because she is a citizen informant who had personal knowledge of the matters in which she spoke.
15. On June 9, 2006, June 12, 2006, and April 29, 2008 your affiant and SA Christophersen spoke with Debbie Raskie. Debbie is the ex-wife of Michael Raskie. Debbie stated she married Michael Raskie in 1972. Debbie stated in June of 1987 Michael Raskie began working as a foreman at the Marquip, Inc. Debbie stated Michael worked second shift during this time. Debbie stated Michael began staying out late and not coming home after work. Debbie stated she is the Human Resources Manager at Phillips Plating and knew Marchelle Hansen as she had also worked at Phillips Plating. Debbie stated after Marchelle began working at Marquip, Inc. she began hearing Marchelle talking to other workers at Phillips Plating about her foreman. Debbie stated Marchelle was visiting with employees at the business during these times. Debbie stated she found it strange that Marchelle was talking about her husband, Michael Raskie. Debbie stated she recalled Marchelle coming to Phillips Plating telling employees she was pregnant. Debbie stated Michael Raskie told her Marchelle brought him dinners at work. Debbie stated Michael Raskie told her that he couldn't get rid of Marchelle Hansen and made comments that "she was in my office again." Debbie stated she recalled hearing Marchelle was missing while she (Debbie) was at the IGA grocery store in Phillips, WI. Debbie stated she told Michael Raskie that Marchelle was missing. Debbie stated Michael stated "well she is a sick human being anyway". Debbie Raskie stated at the time of Marchelle Hansen's disappearance Michael Raskie's brother Steven Raskie rented a residence in the vicinity of State Highway 111 owned by the Wanish's. Debbie stated Steven Raskie worked on road construction during that time. Debbie stated Steven Raskie allowed them (she and

Michael Raskie) to store items in a shed on the property. Debbie stated she and Michael Raskie stored a lawn mower and a dirt bike in the shed and also may have stored a motorized tricycle and a Harley Davidson motorcycle. Debbie stated she recalled they stored items for the winter during one or two seasons. Your affiant believes the information provided by Debbie Raskie because she is a citizen informant who had personal knowledge of the matters in which she spoke.

16. On May 19, 2008 your affiant reviewed Wisconsin Department of Transportation (D.O.T.) records kept by the Wisconsin Historical Society. These records indicate that Michael D. Raskie owned two vehicles registered as a motorcycle in 1986, three vehicles registered as a motorcycle in 1987, and four vehicles registered as a motorcycle in 1988. Your affiant believes this information as they were Wis. D.O.T. records kept during the aforementioned years archived the historical society purposefully kept as a historical record.
17. On October 6, 2003 your affiant spoke with Alice Wanish at her residence at N6658 Pioneer Road in the Township of Harmony. Alice indicated Steven Raskie had lived at the residence as she and her late husband Tom had rented it out in the past. Alice stated she could not remember exactly which years Steven Raskie lived at the residence but thought he may have lived at the residence during 1987 and 1988. Alice stated she cleaned the residence when Steven Raskie lived there. Alice indicated Steven always left the residence open. Your affiant believes the statements of Alice Wanish because she is a citizen informant who had personal knowledge of the matters in which she spoke.
18. On August 18, 2004, August 27, 2004 and June 24, 2005 your affiant and SA Christophersen spoke with Michael Raskie at his residence in Bayfield County. During the course of these interviews Michael indicated he was employed at the Marquip Corporation from approximately 1980 until 1989. Michael stated he knew of Marchelle Hansen when he worked at Marquip. Michael stated he was a fabricator foreman and worked a 3 p.m. to 11p.m. shift. Michael indicated Marchelle worked the same shift. Michael stated it was common for some employees after work to stop at a tavern drink beer and play darts. Michael stated he and Marchelle were part of a group of employees who commonly met after work. Michael stated he was aware that Marchelle was saying she was pregnant. Michael stated prior to that time he had thought to himself that Marchelle was capable of manipulating someone over a pregnancy. Michael stated "Sometimes you had the feeling like she would do something like that to someone". Michael stated Marchelle told him that she was pregnant. Michael stated at the time he drove a Ford pickup with large tires and a double chrome roll bar. Michael stated Marchelle drove a red colored midsize car. Michael was asked about any theories he had about Marchelle Hansen's disappearance. Michael stated "It doesn't look good at this time. Do you know about the Lori Hacking case? He shot her in the head? Dumpster picked her up? A pregnancy maybe? Without finding a body I don't think they could be sure of it." During the course of these interviews Michael Raskie has denied any involvement in any type of sexual relationship with her or any involvement in Marchelle Hansen's disappearance. Michael stated "Couldn't a person pay child support or a financial settlement of \$5 or \$10 thousand dollars". Michael stated his wife may have had

something to do with Marchelle's disappearance. Michael stated he thought his wife may have thought he was having extra-marital relations with Marchelle. Michael asked what if more than one person was involved in Marchelle's disappearance. What would be the reason that person wouldn't say anything. Michael was asked if he had ever been inside Marchelle Hansen's vehicle. Michael stated he may have sat in the passenger seat. Your affiant believes the information provided by Michael Raskie in as much as he indicates knowledge of Marchelle Hansen and her pregnancy and that his statements are against his penal interest.

19. On May 9, 2007 your affiant spoke with G. Janet Prohaska, the mother of Dale Prohaska. Janet stated on Friday, November 13, 1987 she arrived at the Lake 10 Resort. Janet stated she observed a small red colored car in the parking lot. Janet stated the car was parked at an unusual angle. Janet stated it looked to her that someone had coasted the car into the lot or had gotten out of the car hurriedly. Janet stated she called the Sheriff's Department on Saturday, November 14, 1987. Janet stated she provided the license plate number to the Sheriff's Department and was told that the vehicle was owned by Marchelle Hansen. Janet stated her daughter Connie Runnheim also came to the resort. Janet stated Connie was a friend of Marchelle. Janet stated Connie said it was not right for the vehicle to be there. Your affiant believes the information provided by G. Janet Prohaska because she is a citizen informant who had personal knowledge of the matters in which she spoke.
20. On September 19, 2007 your affiant located an officer's daily activity report completed by Deputy Ross Honsa on November 14, 1987. The report indicates that at 3:39 p.m. Deputy Honsa received a call from Janet Prohaska for information on KL5306. Your affiant is aware that KL5306 is the license plate number of Marchelle Hansen's vehicle. Your affiant believes the report completed by Deputy Honsa because at the time of this report he was a law enforcement officer who acquired the information through the course of duty.
21. On August 31, 2006 your affiant collected DNA swabs from the interior of the Marchelle Hansen vehicle. Your affiant collected nine swabs from different areas of the interior including the steering wheel, interior door handle areas, light switch, etc. On September 1, 2006 your affiant submitted these DNA swabs to the Wisconsin State Crime Laboratory in Madison for analysis. On October 30, 2007 your affiant received a report completed by Analyst James Andreas which indicates that DNA was located on a swab of the left side of the steering wheel of the Marchelle vehicle. Testing results indicate a mixture of DNA from at least three individuals, with at least one male donor. Testing results of a swab of the right front passenger side arm rest/door handle area indicate partial DNA mixtures of at least two individuals, with at least one male donor.
22. On October 18, 2007 your affiant submitted DNA standard samples taken from Gary White and Stanley Mindock. Mindock is the wrecker operator who towed Marchelle Hansen's vehicle to the Sheriff Department impound area. Your affiant has reviewed a report dated December 13, 2007 completed by DNA analyst James Andreas which indicates that the DNA standard of Gary White and Stanley Mindock were compared with the male unknown DNA located in Marchelle Hansen's vehicle. That the report


indicates that the male unknown DNA was not identified as that of either Gary White or Stanley Mindock. Your affiant believes the information provided by the WI state crime laboratory because it is a fellow law enforcement agency whom your affiant has used in the past and found to be reliable.

23. On April 11, 2008 your affiant obtained a DNA standard from Steven Raskie and submitted it to the Wisconsin State Crime Laboratory. On May 9, 2008 your affiant received a report indicating that Steven Raskie is excluded as the contributor of the unknown male DNA located in Marchelle Hansen's vehicle.
24. Your affiant believes the information contained in the reports from analysts of the Wisconsin State Crime Laboratory as your affiant is aware that these analysts receive specialized training in their field of analysis and that your affiant has relied upon other information obtained from the Wisconsin State Crime Laboratory and found it to be reliable.
25. On May 19, 2008 your affiant reviewed records of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation which indicate that Michael Raskie has an address of 79985 S. Fay Rd., Port Wing, Bayfield County, WI. Your affiant believes the information of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation as it is information commonly kept in the course of business which you affiant has relied upon in the past and found to be reliable
26. Your affiant knows from his training and experience as an investigator that the individual make up of a human being contains a substance commonly known as DNA. That our individual DNA makeup is unique. That a DNA standard of an individual can be used as comparison with DNA evidence left at the scene of a crime or in a vehicle and can be used as evidence in an attempt to establish if and/or where an individual handled a certain item and/or was present in a particular location or vehicle.
27. It is your affiant's belief that Marchelle Hansen is the victim of a homicide. Based on the above information, Michael D. Raskie is a suspect in Marchelle Hansen's disappearance and homicide. Your affiant is aware that 1st Degree Intentional Homicide and conspiracy to commit the same are felony offenses and that these are violations of state and federal law.
28. That based on the foregoing your affiant requests that a search warrant be issued to search the person of Michael D. Raskie for a sample of his DNA.
29. That your affiant believes that on the basis of the foregoing facts, that in and upon certain person known as Michael D. Raskie there may now be located and concealed certain things, to wit: a DNA sample.
30. That your affiant believes the DNA sample may contain evidence which tends to show that a crime has been committed, First degree intentional homicide, contrary to 940.01, Wis. Stats.

1 31. WHEREFORE, your affiant respectfully requests that this court issue a search warrant
2 pursuant to 968.12, Wis. Stats., to search the person of Michael D. Raskie, and to seize
3 the DNA sample, and to return this warrant within 48 hours to this court.


16 WHEREAS, the application and supporting affidavit of Christopher F. Jarosinski were

19 NOW THEREFORE, the Court finds that probable cause exists to believe that the DNA
20 of Michael D. Raskie may constitute evidence of the offense of First degree intentional
21 homicide, contrary to Section 940.01, Wis. Stats.

23 The Court further finds that probable cause exists to believe that DNA is located in the
24 body of Michael D. Raskie.
